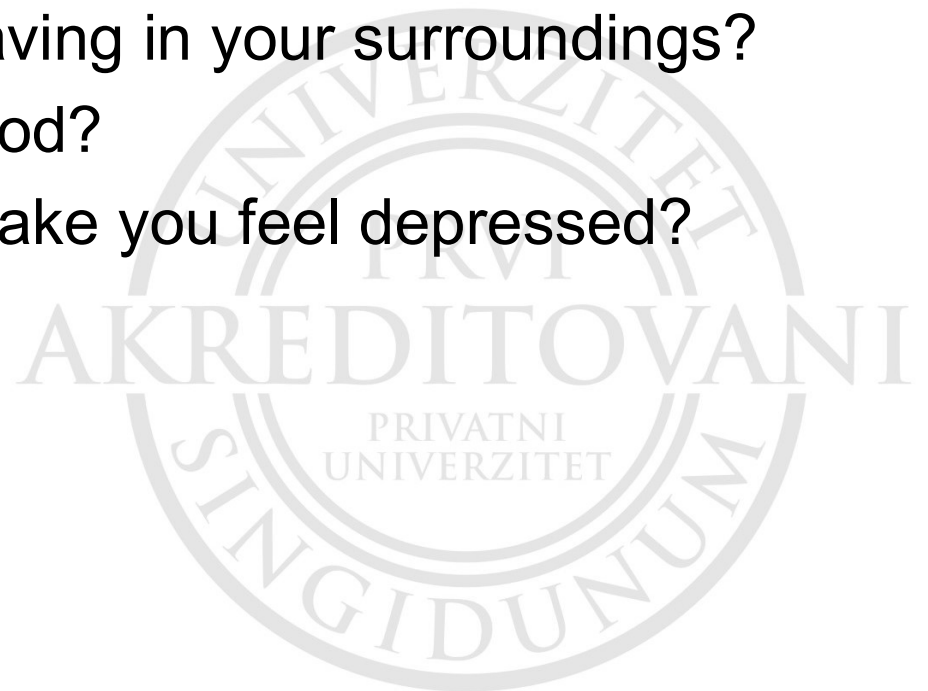


Week IV – The power of design

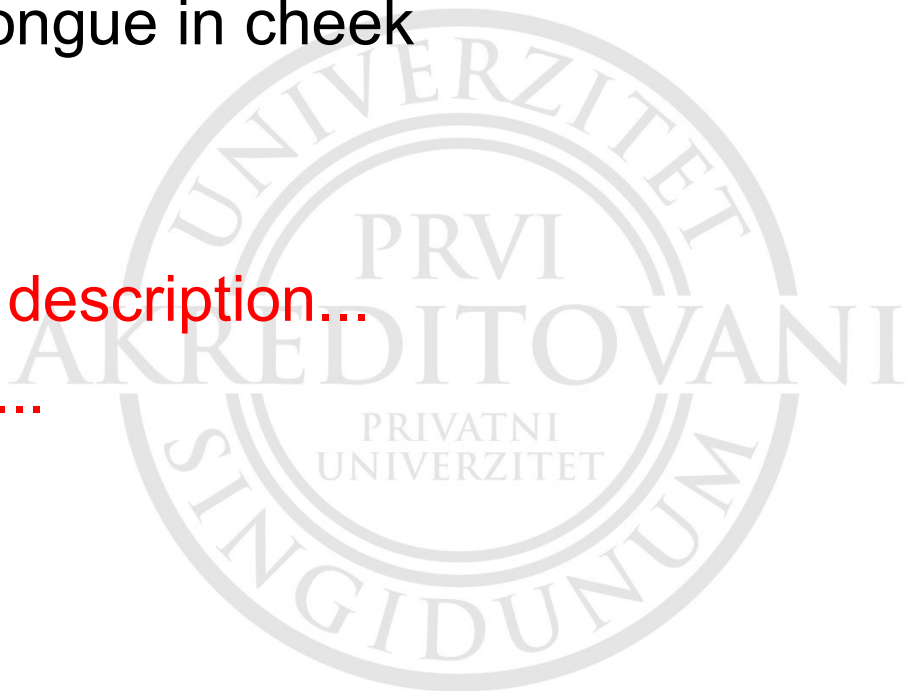
Key words:
