Grammar: Inversion (used for emphasis)

Negative word + question for emphasis

Never in my life have I seen such a beautiful lady.

Words and expressions:

Never, rarely, seldom, barely, scarcely...when, hardly ever, hardly...when, no sooner...than, only, not only...but also, not once, not until, not often, on no account, under no circumstances, by no means, in no way, at no time, nowhere, little



Examples:

- Never in my life had I felt so embarrassed.
- Rarely does he use his credit card.
- No sooner had I told him the news than everybody in the village knew it!
- Only when you see her will you realise how much she has changed.
- Only in an emergency should you dial 999.
- Not only did I lock the door, but I also secured the windows.



- Not even once did she look in this direction.
- Not until I saw him in person did I realise how tall he was.
- In no way is he to blame for what happened.
- <u>Under no circumstances</u> should you go back into a burning building.
- <u>Little</u> did he know that a surprise awaited him.
